## Meteoric progress at Harrods

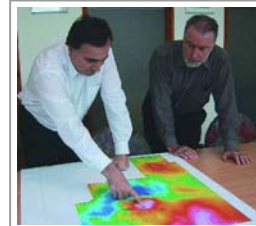

**METEORIC Resources hopes to have a resource estimate for the Harrods Central prospect at its Wilthorpe project by the end of the year, after a major drill out of the prospect based on the results of a report from its geological consultants, expected in mid-August.**

After a 54-hole reverse circulation drilling program, Meteoric has for the first time been able to determine the geometry of the mineralisation at Harrods Central, interpreted as a number of steep-dipping east-northeast trending quartz veins and stringers.

The mineralised zones range in thickness from 0.5-5m and remain open at depth and along strike, according to Meteoric.

Best hits from the program include 7m at 13.4 grams per tonne gold from 35m and 10m at 7.1gpt from 23m. The program tested just 20% of Harrods Central.

Meteoric managing director Roger Thomson told *MiningNews.net* he was hopeful the mineralisation was open pitable but would wait until he receives a report from consultants Ravensgate before declaring potential mining methods at Harrods.

The Ravensgate report will be used to determine the drilling program required to put a resource estimate on Harrods Central, found 25km south of the Fortnum gold mine in Western Australia.

Drilling will likely begin in the current quarter, and with the company raising about \$1 million in February, Thomson said the company has the necessary funding required for the program.

"We're okay in terms of finances at the moment but depending on the market, we may look at that again," he said.

In addition, drilling at Harrods South, 1km south of Harrods Central returned a number of mineralised hits, which will likely be followed up in conjunction with the Harrods Central drilling, according to Meteoric.

Shares in Meteoric rose 3.5c (12.5%) on the news during the morning to be trading at 31.5c.
